

Sick School Syndrome Statistics

- According to the Education Writers Association, 25% of the nation's schools are inadequate. Of these, 42% had environmental hazards; 61% needed maintenance or major repairs.
- According to the American Association of School Administrators, one building in every 8 or 13,200 schools across the nation are inadequate places for learning.
- Nearly 5 million children are subjected to substandard schools every day.
- One million children are sitting in classrooms in buildings that are structurally unsound.
- According to the U.S. Government Accounting Office, our aging schools need \$112 billion for repairs and upgrades.
